Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace! **This Sunday we celebrate World Mission Sunday!** On this special day, we are reminded of the universal call of our Baptism to be Christ's witnesses to the world (Archdiocese of St. Louis Mission Office). Pope Francis, exhorts us, "May all of us, the baptized, be ready to set out anew, each according to our state in life, to inaugurate a new missionary movement, as at the dawn of Christianity!" (*Message for World Mission Sunday 2024*). **The theme chosen by the Holy Father for this year's World Mission Sunday is "Go and invite everyone to the banquet" (Matthew 22:9).** This theme reminds us of the extraordinary gift we have as Catholics, every week, to sit at the table of the Lord and participate in the Eucharistic meal. For it is truly, we believe, a foretaste of the final banquet, salvation in the Kingdom of God. Mindful of such an immeasurable gift, let us be eager to share it with all to whom we come in contact. Consider inviting a friend or a loved one to Mass! It sure is wonderful when we have a host of new guests standing up at the end of Mass to be welcomed and lauded.

**Every year, October 20<sup>th</sup>, marks the beginning of a special spiritual discipline for me. I like to refer to it as the "St. Paul of the Cross Diet."** So, on October 20<sup>th</sup>, we celebrate the Feast of St. Paul of the Cross (This year the feast day is trumped by the Sunday celebration). St. Paul of the Cross was the founder of the Passionists, a congregation of religious men and women, and several years ago, when I was a seminarian student, I had the privilege to visit a convent of Passionist nuns here in the St. Louis area (Ellisville). That day, I learned all about the life of St. Paul of the Cross, but what really made a lasting impression on me was learning about his dying words. Before he transitioned from this life, I was told, he urged his spiritual children, "Don't complain... Don't excuse yourself..." and finally, "Don't harbor resentment." For whatever reason, those words really stayed with me, and I decided to make a concerted effort to uphold his advice, hence, the "St. Paul of the Cross Diet." Now, I wouldn't say I was terribly successful with my efforts, but thanks be to God, at least it has helped me to become aware of how much I fall prey to those "spiritual pitfalls." That awareness has been key, for it has helped me to make improvements year-by-year. So, once again, I take up my "spiritual discipline" and go to work. Perhaps, you might consider joining me!

Well, have a blessed week and know of my prayers for you and your loved ones! God bless you!

The Knights and Ladies of Peter Claver invite you to be a Sock Angel. Please drop a new pair of socks in the box starting September 16 through November 17.

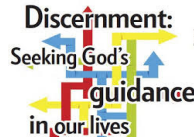

### **STEWARDSHIP ALIVE**

Consider some of these thoughts on Stewardship and becoming a disciple-maker.

- ⇒ Before you can help others, you have to be a disciple in more than word only.
- ⇒ People believe people who “walk the talk”.
- ⇒ Ask the Holy Spirit for guidance. He will show up.
- ⇒ Do it for the glory of God, not the glory of me.
- ⇒ We plant the seeds of faith; the Holy Spirit does the actual conversion.
- ⇒ Active listening - listen to understand, not to build your response or explain why they are wrong.
- ⇒ The core of friendship is trust and the seed of trust is humility.
- ⇒ Walking with someone on their faith journey means that I am available to them on their schedule, not mine.
- ⇒ Share your faith story with others; share the highs and lows of your faith journey.
- ⇒ Personal invitations work the best.
- ⇒ Inviting someone to Mass may not be the first step, may need to build up to that; invite them to events that they may have interest in first.

**A Mass Offering is an offering attached to celebrating a Mass for a particular intention;** i.e., healing, death, special anniversary, special birthday or special intention. Mass offerings may be requested for a special date; i.e., anniversary of death, wedding anniversary, etc., but must be verified the date is available and has not already been requested by another individual. Only one offering a day is permitted. This verification is done by Fr. Scheiderer. The offering to be given for the celebration of the Mass for a particular intention is ten dollars for the Province of St. Louis. “If a member of the faithful spontaneously gives a larger or smaller offering, however, it may be accepted.” The Mass Offering will be recorded in the Parish bulletin. Envelopes are available at the entrances to church for your convenience.
