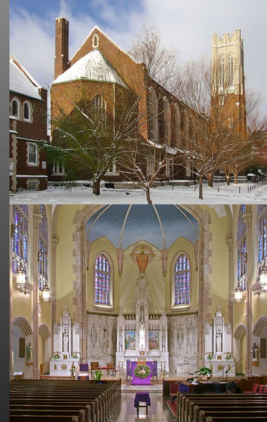

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace! I hope these words find you well in the Lord! I'd like to offer a huge "thank you" to all who made the *Corpus Christi* procession possible last week: clergy, parish staff, the liturgy committee, sanctuary ministers, music ministers, volunteers, and of course, the faithful participating in the event. It was such a powerful witness of faith, and I look forward to future processions!

**An additional debt of gratitude is owed to all who put in the time and effort to ready our St. Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist (SEMJB) location for worship!** A tremendous amount of work went into reopening SEMJB (construction, maintenance, cleaning, decorating, rearranging, and the list keeps going...), and I'm incredibly thankful to all who assisted in the process. This will be an emotional homecoming for all who hail from SEMJB and have associations with it. It has been about 2 years since there has been a Mass offered in the Church. What a blessing it will be for our whole parish family to come together for this momentous occasion! As mentioned in previous weeks, we will be at the SEMJB site for a three month stay (through the month of August).

**In our gospel this week, we hear about the "everlasting sin," the blasphemy against the Holy Spirit (Mark 3:29).** It's hard not to be triggered by these words of our Lord in some manner. What is this sin against the Holy Spirit, and how do we avoid it? Several years ago, I came across a helpful passage in understanding this unpardonable sin. In Dr. Alan Schreck's "*Your Life in the Holy Spirit: What Every Catholic Needs to Know and Experience*", he explains, "Sin against the Holy Spirit involves either a refusal to repent—that is, a refusal to acknowledge one's sins when the Holy Spirit points them out or a refusal to accept God's forgiveness, which Christ offers through the Holy Spirit. One cannot be forgiven if one rejects the agent through which forgiveness is extended. That is why the sin against the Holy Spirit is unforgivable—not because God is unwilling to forgive, but because the person refuses to accept God's forgiveness through the Holy Spirit" (96). Let us pray, then, for greater openness and docility to the Holy Spirit in our life. May we as a parish family welcome this unfathomable "gift of God" into our hearts and minds that He may effect in us change that is in accord with the Kingdom of Heaven! Come, Holy Spirit, Come!
