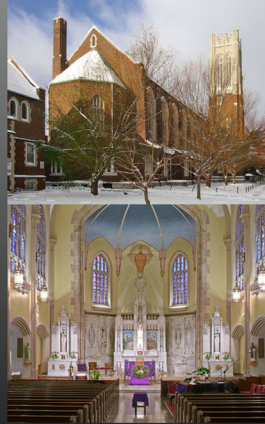

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace! **A blessed Pentecost weekend to you all!** Pentecost, as many of you know, marks the close of the Easter season. Christ’s Paschal Mystery, that is His Passion, Death, and Resurrection, has been received by the Father into eternal glory (Christ’s Ascension into heaven) and now, its saving effects are being poured forth upon humanity through the Holy Spirit. This pouring forth, thus, ushers in a new age, the age of the Church. In fact, **Pentecost is often referred to as the “birthday” of the Church.** The *Catechism of the Catholic Church* explains, “By his coming, which never ceases, the Holy Spirit causes the world to enter into the ‘last days,’ the time of the Church, the Kingdom already inherited though not yet consummated” (no. 732).

Next week, to signify this change liturgically, we’ll be back in Ordinary Time. Now, we call it “Ordinary Time,” but you and I know, it is a time of extraordinary grace! I pray that we, as a parish family, are able to open our hearts and minds anew to the transformative power of the Holy Spirit in this new season.

As many of you know, this weekend is a very special weekend for **our beloved seminarian, Will Carey.** On Saturday, 5/18, he will be ordained a transitional deacon for the Archdiocese of Kansas City. Congratulations to Will! Join me in praying for him and all those being ordained to the priesthood and the diaconate in the coming weeks. As Will mentioned before he left, he will be back in the Fall to assist at a Mass and preach his “first homily” to our parish.

Speaking of transitional deacons... **Join me in welcoming Deacon Bob Hennekes to our parish for the summer!** Deacon Bob is a seminarian of the Archdiocese of St. Louis set to be ordained a priest in May of 2025. He will be with us through mid-July serving as deacon in various capacities throughout our four parishes. This will be part of his pastoral formation as he enters into his final year of seminary. Welcome, Deacon Bob! Our prayerful support is with you!

Again, a blessed Pentecost to you all! Together, let us pray: “Come, Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of Your faithful and enkindle in them the fire of Your Love. Send forth Your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.”

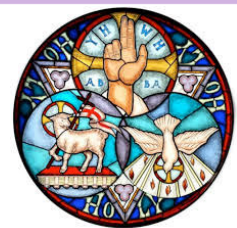
