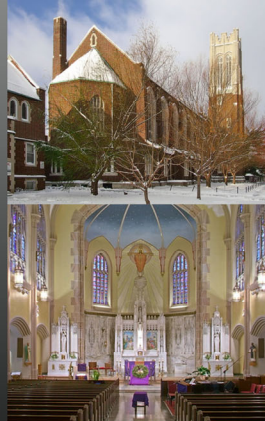

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace! **A huge thank you to all our youth stepping-up in various roles to serve at our Youth Sunday Mass!** We have new altar servers, lectors, ushers, and choir members! We'd love to have even more volunteers, so young adults and youth, consider helping out. Remember, our Youth Sunday is every 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday at the 10:00 a.m. Mass. Also, **congratulations to Mr. Samuel Wynn**, a graduated senior from St. Mary's High School who was awarded the Eagle Scout honor. We are all very proud of you, Samuel! Mr. Samuel Wynn was also a St. Charles Lwanga Center youth honoree this year along with **Mr. Carl "C.J." Summers**, who frequently serves as a lector at our Youth Sunday. **Thank you, gentlemen, for your extraordinary witness to our parish!** We are praying for you and all our graduated seniors as you take the next step in your life journey!

**This Sunday, the 17<sup>th</sup> Sunday in Ordinary Time, we begin a special 5-week journey through the exalted "Chapter 6" of the Gospel of John.** This is something we do once every 3 years as we are on a 3-year reading cycle with our Sunday lectionary. If you recall, this liturgical year (Year "B") we are centered on the *Gospel of Mark*, and since the *Gospel of Mark* is a shorter gospel, we take a "pause" from reading his gospel to dive deep with *John*, "Chapter 6." Now, this chapter of the *Gospel of John* is very significant because it contains Jesus' famous "Bread of Life Discourse," his teaching on the Holy Eucharist. So, for 5 weeks, we will explore this instruction and enter-in to the mystery of Jesus' Real Presence as the Holy Eucharist.

It's certainly no coincidence, now that the National Eucharistic Congress and this 3-year-focused Eucharistic Revival has concluded, we have the opportunity to bask in what Jesus has revealed through Sacred Scripture regarding this wondrous Sacrament. Definitely take advantage of this time! Perhaps, consider joining the last week of our faith-formation series on the Eucharist. The *Presence* video series will conclude this week with its 3<sup>rd</sup> installment after the 10:00 a.m. Mass in the rectory basement. **Thank you, Mrs. Alfreda Pulley and the Spiritual Life Committee, for coordinating this fantastic study!**

The offering to be given for the celebration of the Mass for a particular intention is ten dollars for the Province of St. Louis. "If a member of the faithful spontaneously gives a larger or smaller offering, however, it may be accepted." The Mass Offering will be recorded in the Parish bulletin.

**\*New Parish Name - it is not too late to submit your suggested name for the new parish.** When the decision regarding the appeal is finalized, our parish will continue with the process of naming the new parish (whether it is a three or four parish merger). So, if you have a parish name in mind, now would be a good time to share it with our parish family. Just write the new name you have in mind, who is submitting the proposal and a short write up why you believe this to be a candidate to consider for our new parish name. Send that or give that write up to Fr. Scheiderer.
