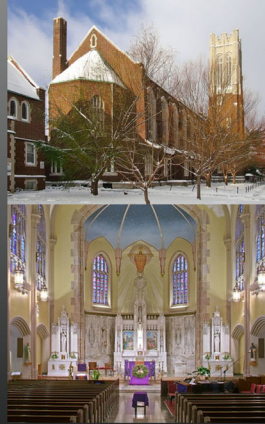

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace! As we celebrate the Fifth Sunday of Lent, we enter into a period of the Lenten season traditionally known as "Passiontide." It marks the final two weeks of this holy season of penitence and serves as a reminder to intensify our prayer and preparation for the celebration of the Easter mysteries. In the ancient world, monks who had chosen the eremitical life, a more austere mode of life characterized by almost unbroken solitude, would return to their monasteries to be with their communities in prayer. What a great sign for all of us in these final weeks of Lent to make a concerted effort to be together as a parish family united in prayer!

On this Fifth Sunday of Lent at the 10:00 a.m. Mass, we also celebrate the "Third Scrutiny" for our candidates who are planning to be received into full communion with Catholic Church at Easter. This final "Scrutiny" (Again, the scrutinies are specific rites designed to encourage and strengthen our candidates.) focuses on receiving Christ, who is "the resurrection and the life" (John 11:25). At this Mass, the Gospel of the "Raising of Lazarus from the Dead" (John 11:1-45) will be proclaimed.

A couple weeks ago in my "Pastor's Pen," I noted that the month of March is dedicated to St. Joseph, the universal patron and protector of the Church. Well, our dear spiritual father's feast day is now upon us (March 19th)! This weekend, loaves of blessed St. Joseph's bread will be distributed to the faithful (one per household) compliments of the Blum family from the Our Lady of the Holy Cross location. Thank you, Blums! St. Joseph, pray for us!

Know that my prayers continue for you all! Let us remain steadfast in our Lenten commitments as we enter into these final weeks. The finish line is close! Let us "Run so as to win" (1 Corinthians 9:24).

FEAST OF ST. JOSEPH

St. Joseph's Day is celebrated on March 19 every year. The day commemorates the feast of St. Joseph, the husband of the Virgin Mary and foster-father of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.



At this weekend's Masses and also at daily Mass on Tuesday, March 19, the actual Feast Day of St. Joseph, we will distribute specially prepared bread that will be blessed.

This bread is baked in symbolic shapes to honor St. Joseph's profession, in shapes of carpenter's tools such as ladders, saws and hammers.

Also, the use of bread crumbs in food preparation is said to represent saw dust in commemoration of St. Joseph's work as a carpenter.

This custom established in Rome in 1479 was extended to use in the entire Roman Rite by Pope Pius V's Apostolic Constitution on July 14, 1570.

You can pick up your St. Joseph's bread at one of the entrances to church.

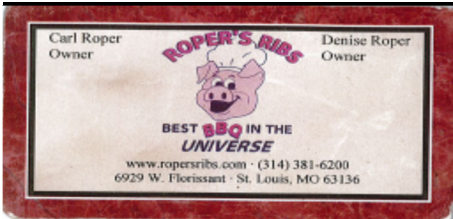
