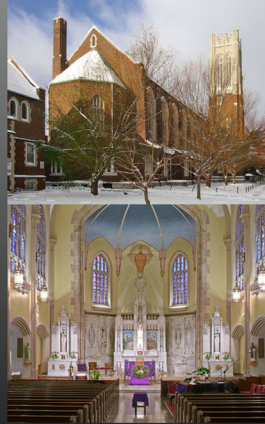

Divine Mercy Sunday

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace and happy Easter! Today’s celebration of the Second Sunday of Easter marks the close of the “Easter Octave.” As mentioned last week, the Easter festivities are so glorious that they are not limited to just one day; rather, they extend over eight days. **Now, the Easter Octave in recent years of Church history has ended or culminated in what is known as Divine Mercy Sunday.**

The first Divine Mercy Sunday was celebrated by the Church universal in the year 2000. It was Pope St. John Paul II who officially designated the Second Sunday of Easter to be Divine Mercy Sunday. **The roots of Divine Mercy Sunday, however, date back much farther to a series of apparitions of our Lord to a young Polish nun, St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, in the 1930s.** These apparitions are recounted in her diary, *Divine Mercy in My Soul*, a true spiritual masterpiece!

In one of St. Faustina’s later apparitions, Jesus instructed her to have the Sunday after Easter Sunday designated as Divine Mercy Sunday. Now, what is of the utmost importance regarding this particular solemnity is the promise Jesus afforded the faithful on this day: **“The soul that will go to confession and receive Holy Communion shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.** On that day all the divine floodgates through which grace flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet... Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy” (*Diary of St. Maria Faustina Kowalska*, 699).

What an extraordinary grace! I sure hope you avail yourself of this opportunity. For those interested, **additional time for confession will be offered this Sunday afternoon starting at 2:00 p.m. at our St. Matthew, the Apostle, location.** A formal praying of the Divine Mercy Chaplet will also take place at 3:00 p.m. Come and participate if you are available!

“Give thanks to the Lord for He is good; His mercy endures forever! (Psalm 107:1).

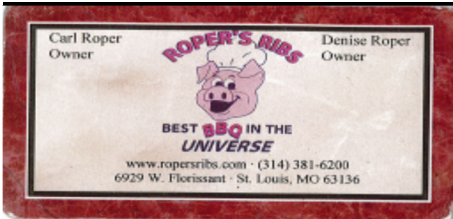
