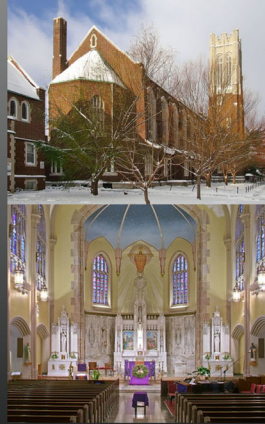

Any child or youth in the second grade or older who has been baptized: There will be a **mandatory orientation meeting** for parents (only) of children preparing to receive First Holy Communion (Eucharist) this year.

**† Confirmation:**

Any youth who has been baptized and must be in grades 7th-12th and at least 12 years of age at the time of the administration of the Sacrament. All candidates and their families must attend an information session prior to enrollment.

**† All other sacramental needs:** Contact the parish office.

**Sacramental Preparation:** If you or anyone you know is in need of **any** sacrament, please contact the parish office immediately. It will soon be too late to enroll in many of these sessions this school year.

### **Transition Team Update**

On Wednesday, February 7<sup>th</sup>, the Transition Team met online via Google Meet. After grounding our meeting in prayer, I followed-up on a couple of items discussed the previous month. I was pleased to announce **developments with our outreach to the youth and young adults**. Now, every fourth Sunday (“Youth Sunday”), our youth group and young adults will meet for a gathering following the 10:00 a.m. Mass. Also, our Youth Coordinator, Miss Vickie Rainey, along with our Young Adult Coordinator, Miss Tesha Stevenson, will be organizing “outings” (recreational activities, educational opportunities, etc.) with our youth/young adults every 2-3 months. Further, a debt of gratitude is owed to our youth leadership team and to our young adults and youth who have put forth such a tremendous effort in presenting us with informative and inspiring talks this Black History Month!

I also followed-up on **the publication of a list of the various committees/organizations associated with our parish**. The past two weeks, an insert has been added to our bulletin summarizing the various committees/organizations and their primary contact. This is a “working document” so if you are aware of a group or an organization that is not mentioned or if the contact information provided is incorrect, please let our parish offices know.

On January 25<sup>th</sup>, **Archbishop Rozanski announced to the public his plan for a “new, dynamic movement of evangelization” in our Archdiocese**, a movement marked by “newfound passion, innovative methods, and fresh expressions.” To articulate his vision, the Archbishop published a document entitled, “Disciples Make Disciples.” I introduced this document to the Transition Team, and I encouraged them to review, study, and pray with it so we can begin to discuss evangelization efforts in our parish and in the surrounding community. This document is available online at “[theway.archstl.org](http://theway.archstl.org)” along with a host of other resources regarding evangelization. Copies of this document will be available at the weekend Masses near the entrances/exits of the church.

Next at our meeting, I gave an **update on the various building and maintenance projects at our sites**. I was pleased to announce that the rectory repairs at our **St. Matthew location** are now complete. On Christmas Eve of 2022, a frozen pipe burst causing extensive damage to the west end of the rectory building. The damage to the building was covered by an insurance claim and the Annual Catholic Appeal was generous in giving us an emergency grant to cover the needed abatement work (asbestos removal). At our **St. Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist** site, plans to repair the church interior are underway. An abatement is also needed at this site, and the hope is to have this expense covered, again, by the Annual Catholic Appeal emergency grant. The work thereafter will be covered by an insurance claim.

In other news, **a common website for our merger is being reviewed and discussed**. In the coming weeks, I hope to schedule an online meeting where the Transition Team and I review a presentation of the proposed website for final approval. Look forward to that release! This website will streamline our parish news and information and will promote more effective communication among our four parish sites. Thank you, Miss Shira Truitt and our Communications and Media team, for all your work!

**Plans for the Lent and Easter season were then shared**. We discussed the added Lenten activities such as the Stations of the Cross offered at 12:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Fridays and the additional Mass on Fridays after the 12:00 p.m. Stations. Dates and times for the Holy Week liturgies were also reviewed. These details are available in the bulletin.

Finally, **information regarding our upcoming parish Trivia Night on Saturday, April 20<sup>th</sup>, was highlighted**. Sign-ups are now available. We hope you and your loved ones can join us for this special event.

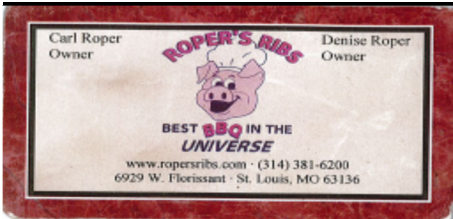
