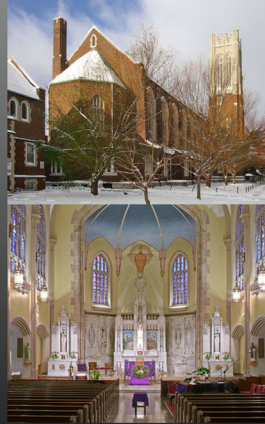

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace! **This past week on Thursday, 4/11, Fr. Chris Adinuba celebrated his 79<sup>th</sup> birthday!** When you get a chance, be sure to extend him a birthday greeting. We are so very blessed by his presence at our parish. Also, at the end of the month (4/30), Fr. Chris will be celebrating his 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of his ordination. Thank you, Father, for your many years of faithful service to Christ and His Church! Our prayerful support is with you!

Today in our Gospel, **we hear St. Luke’s second account of an appearance of the risen Lord.** The first account was when Jesus appeared to the two disciples on the “Road to Emmaus” (Luke 24:13). In this account, Jesus demonstrates the reality of His bodily resurrection in three ways: He invites them to see the wounds in His hands and feet, He prompts them to touch Him, and finally, He asks them for food and then eats it in their presence. Jesus wants them to know, without a shadow of doubt, that He is indeed risen and victorious over death. The reason He’s confirming this reality is, in part, to prepare His disciples for mission. Soon, they will go throughout the world proclaiming that Jesus is Lord!

We too are entrusted with this mission! **The Catechism of the Catholic Church tells us, “all the faithful... have the right and duty, individually or grouped in associations, to work so that the divine message of salvation may be known and accepted by all men throughout the earth” (CCC, para. 900).** It adds, “This duty is the more pressing when it is only through them that men can hear the Gospel and know Christ.” Thus, there is a sense of urgency with this mission. What a great summons for us to pour into our relationship with the Lord! For, the more we come to know Him, the more we are going to be compelled to praise His Holy Name to all we meet. Let us never fail in this mission!

My prayers remain for you all as we progress through this Easter season. May the peace and joy of the risen Lord fill your hearts and minds always! God bless you!

The disciples recounted how their hearts were burning within them when Jesus opened the Scriptures to them. St. Augustine wrote, "In the Old Testament the New Testament is concealed; in the New Testament the Old Testament is revealed." Through typology we can experience spiritual heartburn, the best kind, and more fully appreciate God's plan in salvation history.

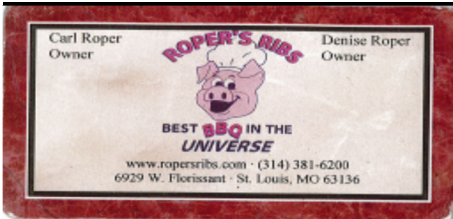
