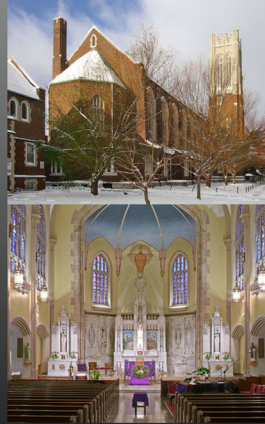

## RECONCILIATION

One (1) hour before Mass and by Appointment

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace to you and peace! **It sure was a joy to participate in our Lenten Day of Recollection last week.** Many thanks, again, to all who organized and joined in this special day! Let us pray that the graces received become enflashed and lived out in a fruitful manner.

Well, **the month of March is upon us, the month dedicated to the patron and protector of the Universal Church, St. Joseph.** March is devoted to St. Joseph because it is in this month that we celebrate his feast day (3/19). It is a longstanding tradition on this special day to bless loaves of bread and then hand them out to the faithful.

If you recall in the Old Testament, the patriarch Joseph held great favor with the pharaoh in Egypt for his ability to predict and plan for the famine that struck Egypt and the surrounding area. Subsequently, Pharaoh set Joseph over his house and over all the land of Egypt (Genesis 41:40-41) with the charge to be the “keeper of the grain,” the person responsible for distributing and rationing Egypt’s food supply. Now, **the Christian tradition sees in this Old Testament patriarch a foreshadowing of the future foster father of Jesus, St. Joseph,** who was appointed by God to be over the “house” of the Holy Family. Just like the patriarch of old, St. Joseph is responsible for a “new bread,” the “Bread of Life” (John 6:35).

In the Middle Ages, the citizens of Sicily were inspired to pray to St. Joseph when they experienced a severe drought and famine. Shortly after calling upon his aid, rain arrived delivering them from their anguish. Thereafter, the people of Sicily celebrated a feast in his honor, and in subsequent years, bread was distributed on his feast day in remembrance of this momentous occasion.

**Thanks to a generous donation from a parishioner, our parish will honor this great tradition** and hand out blessed “St. Joseph” bread the weekend before his feast on Tuesday, March 19<sup>th</sup>. Blessed bread will also be given on the feast day itself at the daily Mass. Look forward to that event!

Well, **our prayers continue for our candidates to be received into the Church this coming Easter!** We will offer prayers in a special way at the 10:00 a.m. Mass this week and in the following two weeks as we celebrate the “Scrutinies,” specific rites designed to encourage and strengthen the candidates in their resolve to follow along the path of Christian perfection. God bless and keep you all! My prayers remain!

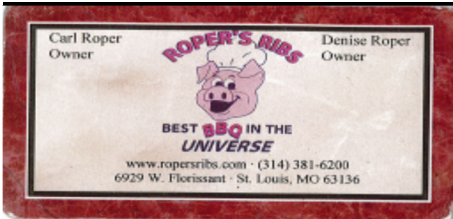
